Winemaker's Comment

Wine of rich bright red colour with intensive aroma of mature spur cherries, roasted coffee beans and nuance of dark berry fruits. Small fruit and harmonic structure of acids and sweet tannins with long aftertaste of roasted coffee beans and plum chutney prevails in the soft taste of the wine.

Vineyard

Planting of Saint Laurent comes from 1956, therefore, it is one of the oldest plantings of this variety in Slovakia. 2017 vintage with sufficient number of sunny and warm days helped this variety to fully show its character. Gbelce have been providing the highest quality grapes for a long time. Saint Laurent 2017 vintage is a clear example.

Cellar

Cold, 48-hour-long maceration follows crushing. The mash is subsequently warmed up and put up for fermentation with selected wine yeasts. Plunging was performed three times a day. When the fermentation is completed, the wine is then subjected to a full malolactic fermentation and is left to age in 225 litre oak barrels for eight months. Smaller part is left in a stainless steel tank and the final blending consisting of stainless steel tank and oak barrels is then bottled without filtering.

Recommended Serving

At the temperature 14 – 15 °C with lamb shank confit with au gratin creamy potatoes.
