Winemaker's Comment

Wine of light yellow-greenish colour. The aroma has a soft herbal-fruity character of a ripe gooseberry, white currant, and a vineyard peach. The taste is fresh, carrying tones of citrus fruits and ripe gooseberry and has a soft lime-spicy aftertaste.

Vineyard

2016 vintage was very good for Sauvignon despite its late spring frosts and September's higher day temperatures. Grapes come from a favourite Pribeta area from local cooperative.

Cellar

Upon quick transport from the vineyards an even quicker processing takes place. The grapes are collected into small 20 kilogram crates, destemmed, crushed, macerated for 2 hours and pressed in a hightech pneumatic press, which provides for a gentle pressing. The juice is subsequently settled at very low temperatures for 48 hours and fermented at low monitored temperatures. The wine ages on lees for another two months before being bottled.

Recommended Serving

At 9 - 10 degrees Celsius with asparagus salad with turkey nuggets.
